## B.I.O.T. Working Papers

Figures in the B.I.O.T. working paper series which refor to the population of Chagos are based on the last full analysis held in Warch 1968, and which owing to the movement of families since that date, should be regarded as only approximate. A further obstacle to accurate assessment of the labour force/family ratio is that some of the married women and older children work as labourers but the proportion fluctuates. In certain instances quoted in relation to commercial aspects the numbers of <u>labourers</u> are calculated rather than those of families, the varying sizes of which make any count no more than quesswork based on past averages.
