Nelson Island.

Two hours were spent ashore at Nelson Island en (a) Lending was made at low tide at route from Salomon to Diego Garcia. the north east of the island and would probably have been impossible when the tide was higher, due to rollers continuing into the beach. The island is approximately one mile long and half a mile wide at the ends, narrowing to quarter of a mile in the centre, with the longer axis running in an east-west direction. The end sections are composed of raised champignon coral, whilst the centre section has sandy beaches. A small grove of cocomuts grows in the centre of the north side of the island and the rest of the island is covered in bushes, mainly velontier (SCREVOLA FRUTESCIES) and bois tabac (TOURREFORTIA ARGENTEA). A large number of sea birds were on the island, including noddies, frigate birds and boobies (both brown and pink fcoted). A large number of turtle nests were also seen on the beaches.

The island which is still privately owned is too (b) small to be of economic significance, even though some guano has been At records of its ever having been inhabited have been traced, but there are a number of domestic bens living wild on the The only sign of habitation seen was a small temporary shelter believed to have been put up some years ago by the owners of Salomon Island and used as a fishing camp.

Plantations 3.

The condition of the plantations remains as in (a) previous reports. On Diego Carcia some areas are no longer being cropped due to the difficulty of clearing, but concentration on more intensive production in the remaining areas has resulted in increased production since this policy was introduced towards the end of 1969.

Details of production are given in Appendix I.

- The cattle on Diego Garcia are doing well as are the pigs on Salomon. These pigs are kept on an open range system and this, rather than sty feeding, is now to be tried on the other islands.
- The buildings remain adequate but a number of roofs are reaching the stage where they will have to be replaced (c) if the buildings are to continue in use.

Labour

Details of the labour force are given in Appendix III and details of earning in Appendix IV. Relations between manage-(a) ment and labour remain generally good. The general condition of the labour lines remains poor, but the standard of cleanliness of the camps has continued to improve. The stock of rations on the islands was adequate and the shops were quite well stocked.

Population

- Details of the population are given in appendix V. There has been a small increase in the number of Seychellois on the islands, but the number of Ilois has remained almost static. Two Ilois families left on the Soruvaer for leave in Fauritius and Houlinie & Co. have undertaken to re-employ them on Agalaga.
 - Details of births, deaths and marriages are given (b) in Appendix VI.

Courts

The Peace Officer's records are generally well kept. (a) Details of cases heard are given in Appendix VII.

Medical

Both a dresser and a midwife are working on Diego Carcia but on the other two atolls both functions are performed by one person. The hospitals are in good condition and are well supplied with drugs. The general health of the population remains satisfactory.

Education

(a) Due to the lack of a suitable person on Salomon, the school there is no longer functioning. There are 24 pupils at Peros Banhos and 30 at Diego Garcia.

Communications

The Northear continues to provide the only perular sea link with the islands, calling approximately every two and a mili months.

Communications

- There are three tractors and trucks and a Toyota pick up on Diego Garcia, but at the time of the visit one tractor and the Toyota were not working. The U.S. Geodetic Survey team have left a Dodge Power Wagon on the island which is being used on the plantation. used on the plantation. It is however in very poor condition.
- The Meteorological Station on Diego Garcia continues to receive and send wireless messages on behalf of the management to Seychelles and to Peros Banhos. There is no transnitter on Salomon but messages can be received.

The islands continue to run as well as can be expected without any capital expenditure being incurred and it seems expected without any capital expenditure being interior and it seems likely that, following the reorganisation of the work on Diego Garcia, there will be a substantial increase in production in 1971.
